### American Fleets 2012 Standard Errata

Annex A: Change the Gunnery Standard of the *Tench*, *Balao*, *Gar*, *Mackerel*, *Tambor*, R class, and O class submarines from IV to GS I. All US submarines, with the exception of the unbuilt Cruiser Submarine, use Gunnery Standard I because of their limited fire control equipment for their deck guns.

Page A-4, *Iowa* class: Change the damage point ratings from 234/467/701/841/934 total to 270/540/809/971/1079 total.

Page A-13, *New Orleans* class. Removed the DC rails from the list of weapons. Only San Francisco was fitted with 2 Mk3 DC rail with 6 Mk7 or 8 Mk6/9 DC. This took place in early 1942, probably March. They were removed during her repairs in Dec 42 - Feb 43.

Remove the references to the DC being removed from the other six ships of the class. They were never fitted.

Page C-1, the US Mk4, 7, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14 3in/23 does not have a second Common round. Delete the second line with all zeroes.

Page C-1, the Mk2 81mm mortar was not used in WW II. Delete it.

Page C-2, the US Mk17 6in/47 gun has a maximum elevation of 20°, and cannot fire into the extreme range band.

Page C-3, the penetration and damage values for the US Mk7 12in/50 Common round are:

Short (0-4.7): 18, 36    Med (4.8-11.8): 13, 30    Long (11.9-18.8): 9/4, 26  
Extreme (18.9-23.5): 7/9, 23

Page C-3, the penetration and damage values for the US Mk8, 9, 10, 12 14in/45 HE round are:

Short (0-6.9): 6, 39    Med (7.0-17.2): 5, 33    Long (17.3-27.4): 3/2, 29    Extreme (27.5-34.3): 2/4, 25
