Errata for Steel Typhoon

Page 7: Japanese forces, last paragraph. Change "different anchorages" to "anchorages in Simpson Harbor, Blanche Bay, Karavia Bay, and and Matupi Harbor"

Page 10: On the map of Rabaul, "Prago Pt." should be labeled "Point Praed." The map section below shows the four anchorages mentioned.

Page 14: In the Japanese forces section, in the second paragraph about the ships, change "in the different anchorages" to "in the different anchorages shown on page 10"

Page 51, Battle of Malacca Strait: The correct scenario date is 15 May 1945. By the time of this battle, HMS Venus (V class DD) has been fitted with the Type 293 radar. On the map on page 52, the number at the right end of the scale should be "40 nm," not "20 nm."

Page 51, Surface Sweep: Change the start time from 0730 to 2330. In the setup, the Japanese start 50 nm west of Shimoneseki, not east.


Page 65: The map to the right can be used for setup.

Page 83, US Forces, Fire Support Sectors: The fire support map described here is shown on the next page.


Page 84, US Forces section radar picket stations: There are 16 stations, not 15.


